

Seal Craft

Through **examination** and **interpretation** the children will **investigate** the **lifecycle** of seals. They will then have the opportunity to make their very own seal beanie at one of the stages in the lifecycle, followed by an opportunity to **see, identify** and **record** the seals using the interactive cameras in the Discovery Centre. This workshop is adapted to puffin craft and gannet craft, dependent on the time of year.
