



FAQs for Parents and Carers Wildlife Club – Spring 2023

1. How does it work?

We meet as a group every other week. The maximum capacity for each group is up to 16 children with 2 assisting adults, per session. Sessions will be a mixture of indoors and outdoors so please dress your child for potentially wet and cold weather. We will start and finish at the Learning Hub, unless the programme states differently.

2. How often can my child attend?

Children will be part of one of two groups: Gannets or Puffins. There will be no separation by age and therefore each group will be mixed ages from P1-P7. We will see a group every other week. Please see the full programme for details.

3. Do I need to sign up my child if they attended last term?

Yes, we will be in touch via email with the Spring 2023 Wildlife Club programme and parental consent/application form. Please complete this and return the form to Jack Cuffley, our Education Officer at education@seabird.org. This is a requirement for all new and returning members. We will then be in touch to confirm your child's place at their chosen session. Please do not attend a session without having received confirmation. If you haven't heard from us within a few days, please get in touch by phone to confirm if we can provide a place.

4. Is there a reason why the session may be cancelled?

The sessions have a minimum group size of 6 children per session, unfortunately we are unlikely to be able to run an activity with group numbers below this.

Our Spring Term activities are primarily based outdoors but we may need to cancel or run an alternative session indoors from our Learning Hub, in the event of poor weather. Please ensure that you are contactable, and we can get in touch via the information you have given on your parental consent form.

5. What cost is there?

This term Wildlife Club we will be charging for the term in its entirety at **£12.50** per child. Once your place is confirmed you will be emailed a link to pay in advanced online, this is our preferred payment method. Alternatively, you can pop into the Centre to make a card, or cash payment before the session begins. Silver members receive 10% discount and Gold members a 20% discount.

6. Will my child be able to return to Wildlife Club if they miss a session?

Yes, if your child cannot attend a session for any reason, just let us know. If you have been a member of our Wildlife Club previously and are looking to return, please still complete an application form and get in touch at education@seabird.org.
