## Quick Guide to Stranded Seal Pups



Many seal pups spotted along the coast will just be resting. Please give them plenty of space and do not allow children or dogs to approach them.

If you are worried about the pup, consider these questions:

- Is the pup still white and fluffy (or partly fluffy)?
- Is the pup visibly skinny (can you clearly see its neck)?
- Is the pup in immediate danger (is it being disturbed by people or dogs)?
- Does it have visible injuries or is it entangled in something?

If the answer to one or more of these questions is yes, call the SSPCA (03000999999) or the British Divers Marine Life Rescue (01825765546) for advice. Remember to note the pup's detailed location. Consider accessibility, the closest road, and any distinctive landmarks.
